The internationally acclaimed organ virtuoso **Thomas Heywood** enjoys an outstanding reputation as one of the world's finest concert organists. Touring annually, he has travelled over 1.2 million kilometres performing solo concerts on the most celebrated pipe organs across the globe.



Johann Vexo is the Choir Organist of Notre-Dame Cathedral in Paris and has performed extensively throughout Europe, the USA, Canada and Russia. A prize-winning performer, he has appeared as a featured artist in numerous international music festivals.

Ned Wright-Smith is the Organ Scholar of St Andrew's Brighton. At only 17, he has performed internationally and is already gaining a new and young audience for the organ through his innovative concert programs from Bach to David Bowie!



The brilliant young Scottish organist **Hannah Gibson** has performed in international music competitions and studied in Birmingham and Vienna. Based in Sheffield, she is a scholarship-winning performer and teacher.

The Indonesian-born, Australian-based prize-winning organist **Ria Angelika Polo** has performed in venues from the Melbourne Town Hall (live on TV) to Cathedrals and University Colleges. She is also a teacher, arranger and international scholarship winner.



Douglas Lawrence OAM has performed throughout most of the Western world and opened the Grand Organ in the Sydney Opera House. He is Director of Music of The Scots' Church, Melbourne and Artistic Director of the Australian Chamber Choir.
