He continued his studies at Melbourne University with British conductor John Hopkins, graduating with a Master of Music. He is currently studying towards a Doctorate in Conducting, and has recently returned from a successful engagement with Orchestra Ensemble Kanazawa, Japan.



Cellist Zoë Knighton is a Masters graduate of Melbourne University and has also studied with Michel Strauss of the Paris Conservatoire. She is a founding member of the Flinders Quartet, one of Australia's leading String Quartets, which performs extensively throughout Australia and overseas. Zoë also performs with duo partner, pianist Elyane Laussade, and as a soloist with university and community orchestras in Victoria.
