She has toured with the Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra, was Principal Flute of the Deutsche Kammerakademie Neuss and has performed as Guest Principal Flute with the City of Birmingham Orchestra, BBC National Orchestra of Wales, and the Australian Chamber Orchestra. From 2003-2005 she played full-time with the Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra and in 2006 was appointed Lecturer of Flute, University of Newcastle.

She has a long-standing collaborative relationship with Elena Kats-Chernin and in 2013 premiered Andrew Ford’s piece for her *Once upon a time there were two brothers...* with the Shanghai String Quartet.
